### In 1994:

Vietnamese Nursing Training Project began. (Trained 56 people)
 Satsukdai Hospital took the lead in foreign nursing training program worked cooperatively with AHP Networks for the first time in Japan. As of 2008, total of 56 people from Vietnam acquired National Nursing License in Japan, and worked in local hospitals. Vietnam's counter-part was MOH, MOLISA and MOEAT, and the person in charge of DOLAB was Mr. Tran Van Hang.

#### 2006:

Satsuki-dai Hospital inducted 5 Vietnamese medical interns.
 The hospital applied Foreign Medical Intern System which is authorized by Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare for the first time in Japan.
